HISTORY

- 1990 The Sunflower Education Project (SEP) began in the slums of Dhaka
- 1991 First ACEF seminar, first Study tour, Terakoya schools opened
- 1992 Girls scholarship program started
- 1996 First Terakoya graduates (year 5), boys vocational schools started
- 1997 Girls vocational schools started
- 1999 SEP renamed to BDP, registration to Bangladesh government
- 2004 ACEF becomes a certified NPO
- 2009 BDP training center installed in Pubail district
- 2019 Niwa Memorial Training Center opened in Jamalpur district
- 2020 30th anniversary memorial, acquirement of good governance certificate
- 2021 Implementation of emergency Covid-19 support measures



Activities in Japan The Asia Christian Education Fund

- **1)Study Tour…** hosted 2 times/year to visit the schools in Bangladesh. Please check out the website for more details.
- **②Events…** occasional seminars about our activities in Bangladesh, regular study group about "dignity" (dignity cafe) held by university students.
- **3**Lecture… sending ACEF staff/board member to share about topics such as Bangladesh and SDGs in schools, events, and workshops.



Activities in Bangladesh Basic Development Partners (BDP)

- **Non-formal elementary education** non-formal education is provided by schools installed and operated by private organisations such as NGOs. BDP currently operates 43 schools.
- **2Vocational training...** BDP operates vocational programs (sewing, electronics, computers, automobile repair)
- **3Other activities…** micro-financing, sanitary/nutritional educational programs, and large scale disaster relief projects.
