Foreword: Dignity and Business (Masanobu Nomura)

Installment of libraries in Samarsingh and Satshimulia

We are very grateful for your support in the crowdfunding campaign "Let's build libraries for the children in Bangladesh!". The library completion in BDP Samarsingh and Satshimulia primary schools was celebrated by the teachers, students and BDP staff. There are 124 students studying at the Samarsingh school, located in Pubail district, and approximately 100 students studying at Satshimulia school which is located in Barisal district. We hope that the students will enjoy learning even more, and discover creative ideas through these libraries!







Mr. Dicko from BDP visited the affiliated organizations

Mr. Dicko, a BDP staff member, completed the training at Asia Rural Institute. From 12/15-19, together with ACEF, Mr. Dicko visited various organizations/supporters and shared about his experience at Asia Rural Institute, and about the current and future activities of BDP. On the 16th, we visited the Toyo Eiwa Kindergarten, 17th at Tomo no Kai, and 18th at Urawa Higashi Church, and finally on the 19th, at Kyoai Gakuen Middle and High School, and were given

the opportunity to speak to the students there.







Mr.Dicko commented how he was nervous in each of his presentations, but felt the warm welcome. It has been a while since we had a BDP staff visit us, so many of the welcoming organizations also informed us that it was a wonderful experience for them also. Besides visiting the supporters and organizations, we were able to gather some people from previous study tours and members of ACEF, as well as board members to meet and spend some time together.
