Today, we hope to share with you 7 articles on our recent activities/projects and upcoming events, along with updates on what is currently happening in Bangladesh.




#### The possibilities of Non-formal education (Kazuhiro Mori, board)

"The activities which ACEF collaborates with BDP is known commonly as "nonformal education". The book Possibilities of Non-formal Education (Ed. Hideki Maruyama and Miyuki Oota) introduces the whole non-formal education in two frameworks: publicity (public or non-public) and formality (formal or non-formal). The author concludes that every education which is outside the frame of public and formal education is a non-formal education, and gives examples of diverse nonformal education across the world. Experiential occasions such as the study tour which takes place outside the classroom are also considered as a non-formal education. At the end of last year, I visited Dhaka to speak about cooperation between Japanese and Bangladeshi high schools. I was also able to take time to visit the BDP office in Dhaka, and to be able to speak with Mr. Ambrose and Mr. Koraya. With the fast development and founding of school systems, it may appear as there are less chances to implement non-formal education. However, when we focus on the community and topic of "high quality education to all", I believe that the potentiality of nonformal education is ever increasing." (Kazuhiro Mori, board member)
